A QUICK REVIEW:

DEUTERONOMY 6:4-9 TELLS US THAT WE ARE TO REMEMBER GOD IN EVERY MOMENT OF OUR DAY. THIS SECTION OF SCRIPTURE IS KNOWN AS THE SHEMA. THE SHEMA WAS REPEATED MULTIPLE TIMES A DAY BY ANCIENT ISRAEL. NOT ONLY THIS, BUT THE SHEMA IS REPEATED MULTIPLE TIMES A DAY IN ISRAEL TO THIS DAY. ACCORDING TO THE SHEMA, WE SHOULD PAY ATTENTION TO GOD WHEN WE SIT, WHEN WE WALK, AND WHEN WE LIE DOWN. ESSENTIALLY, EVERY ASPECT OF OUR LIVES SHOULD BE FILLED WITH CONTINUAL ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF GOD'S PRESENCE. THIS ACKNOWLEDGMENT IS ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT IN OUR FAMILIES.
