FOR STARTERS:

Where do you find peace and comfort?

QUICK REVIEW:

This week Pastor Will preached from Psalm 91 on finding shelter in God. He taught that God alone is our permanent shelter, our deliverance, and our confidence.

DIGGING DEEPER:

1.. Read Psalm 91:1-2 as a group and answer the following questions.

A. Why might the psalmist have used the name "Most High" for God in this case?

B. Do you live your life in the "shadow of the Almighty?"

C. What prevents you from saying to the Lord, "My refuge and my fortress, my God in whom I trust?"

2. Read Psalm 91:3-8 as a group and answer the following questions.

A. How does this section speak specifically to a pandemic?

B. What is the psalmist saying about God's faithfulness when he compares it to "a shield and buckler?"

C. What point might the Psalmist be making in this section with his references to different times of the day?

3. Read Psalm 91:9-13 as a group and answer the following questions.

A. According to this passage, what prevents evil from befalling us?

B. This section refers to everything from striking one's "foot against stone" to deadly animals. What does this say about God's protection?

4. Read Psalm 91:14-16 as a group and answer the following questions.

A. What do the words deliver, protect, answer, rescue, and satisfy say about God?

B. How can verse 16 bring confidence in difficult times?

GROUP CHALLENGE:

During this difficult time, challenge each other to be lights in the darkness. Find your shelter in God such that others marvel at your peace.

FOR PRAYER:

Pray that the "peace of God, which surpasses all understanding" will guard the hearts of Northwest Church in Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:7).
